Agriculture

- 45 governments pledged urgent action to shift to more sustainable farming
 - Some agricultural promises from nations include : UK's aim to have 75% of farming practices low carbon by 2030, Germany's plan to reduce agricultural emissions by 25m tons, Brazil to reduce agricultural emissions by 1 billion tonnes of emissions by 2030, through scaling up the low carbon farming programme.

Adaptation

- \$232 million committed to the Adaptation Fund, with the UK contributing \$20 million
 - Over \$450m to be used to aid locally led approaches to adaptation
 - These adaptation funds are aiming to help countries that are more vulnerable to climate change

1. As 9th November was Gender, Science and Innovation day, a number of goals and agreements were made in order to try and ensure gender equality in the progress made in fighting climate change.

Some of these announcements included: Germany introducing a new gender Strategy under its International Climate Initiative, Nigeria expanding of its Implementation for national Gender and Climate Action Plan and the UK planning how £165 million will be used to address the challenges of gender inequality and climate change
